ALL SINDH YOUTH SPELLING (SEASON 03) – BEE COMPETITION GUIDELINES

(GRADES VIII – XII only)

Mode of Spelling: (ENGLISH LANGUAGE)

- 1. The deadline for the registration is set for Saturday, August 31, 2025.
- 2. Each institution can register only one team.
- 3. Registration forms can be submitted using any of the following modes:
 - a) In Person: Through a representative physically visiting the campus and submitting the form.
 - b) By Courier: Send to the address below. Please ensure the courier reaches by the deadline; dispatch in a timely manner.
 - c) Online: Access and submit via this link. (https://forms.gle/QFRT9zn5yEN2KLtr8)

4. There will be altogether THREE (ROUNDS) as defined under:

Round 1: Spelling Challenge

- a. Each participant from a team will be asked to spell TWO WORDS, one by one;
- b. Altogether spellings of **SIX WORDS** will be asked from a team;
- c. Only the teams spelling all the words correctly will qualify for the next round;
- d. There cannot be discussion amongst the team members;
- e. Any participant who misspells a word, the entire team will stand to disqualify;
- f. Maximum time to spell a word would be <u>30 seconds</u> only. <u>Failure to answer within the time will lead to disqualification;</u>
- g. Participants can ask for the repetition of the word, along with its meaning and usage in the sentence only **TWICE**.

Round 2: Spelling Challenge - Advanced

- a. Each team will be asked to spell a set of FOUR WORDS;
- b. Teams spelling at least three words correctly will qualify for the Final Round;
- c. There can be discussion amongst the team members;
- d. Any member of the team can come forward to spell the word correctly;
- e. Participants will have a maximum of <u>60 seconds</u> only to spell each word correctly. <u>Failure to answer</u> within the time will lead to disqualification;
- f. Participants can ask for the repetition of the word, along with its meaning and usage in the sentence only **TWICE**.

Round 3: Lightning Spelling Round

- a. In this high-paced round, each team will be presented with a set of words to be spelled as swiftly as possible.
- b. Teams must adhere to a time limit of **120 seconds** to spell the entire set of words.
- c. The team that successfully spells the highest number of words correctly within this prescribed time frame will be declared the winner.
- d. **The competitive twist:** As the round progresses, words increase in complexity, adding an element of challenge and excitement to the competition.
- 5. The list of word* for preparation will be available on:
 - a. www.zsc.edu.pk
 - b. www.dirps.gos.pk

*The provided word list is intended solely as a preparation resource and does not guarantee that spellings in the contest will be derived exclusively from this list. You are encouraged to refer additional sources to ensure comprehensive preparation.

- 6. The decision of the jury will be final and not questioned by the participants in any manner whatsoever.
- 7. Participants should reach at the venue at-least 15 minutes before the reporting time.
- 8. It is mandatory to have three members in a team. In-case any <u>ONE</u> registered participant due to some unforeseen circumstance is unable to participate the institution can send in the replacement, which should be notified to the jury. It will be the responsibility of the institutional representative to ensure that the jury is timely notified. This is valid for only one-participant replacement.

- 9. When a word is presented by the jury, the participant is required to follow this sequence:
 - a. Pronounce the word aloud, for example, "STARS."
 - b. Spell the word, enunciating each letter, such as "S T A R S."
 - c. Reiterate the word, speaking it once more, in this case, "STARS."
- 10. Participants will be notified about their results on the same day.
- 11. All the participants will be eligible for a certificate of participation.
- 12. Only the teams qualifying for the finale round shall be invited on the final day of event which shall be notified at a later stage.
