# ANNEXURE - A (FOR PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS ONLY) SPELLING - BEE COMPETITION GUIDELINES (GRADES IX - XII)

## (ENGLISH)

- 1. The deadline for the registration is set for Monday, 30th day of October, 2023.
- 2. The registration Fee per participant is **Rs: 300/- (Three Hundred Rupees only)** whereas, Rs: 900/- (Nine Hundred Rupees only) per team.
- 3. Each institution can register only one team.
- 4. Registration forms, along with the fee, can be submitted either in person through a representative or couriered to the following address\*:
  - D-64, Block H, North Nazimabad, Karachi.
- \*If your institution chooses the courier option, please send only the registration forms. The fee can be submitted on the day of ROUND-ONE. In such cases, kindly notify us via email at <a href="mailto:danyal.hasan@zsc.edu.pk">danyal.hasan@zsc.edu.pk</a> before the registration deadline.
  - 5. There will be altogether THREE (ROUNDS) as defined under:

## Round 1: Spelling Challenge

- a. Each participant from a team <u>will be asked to spell TWO WORDS</u>, one by one;
- b. Altogether spellings of FOUR WORDS will be asked from a team;
- c. Only the teams spelling all the words correctly will qualify for the next round;
- d. There cannot be discussion amongst the team members;
- e. Any participant who misspells a word, the entire team will stand to disqualify;
- f. Maximum time to spell a word would be <u>60 seconds</u> only. <u>Failure to answer</u> <u>within the time will lead to disqualification:</u>
- g. Participants can ask for the repetition of the word, along with its part of speech and usage in the sentence only **TWICE**.

## Round 2: Spelling Challenge - Advanced

- a. Each team will be asked to spell a set of FOUR WORDS;
- b. *Teams spelling at least <u>three words correctly</u> will qualify for the Final Round;*
- c. There can be discussion amongst the team members;
- d. Any member of the team can come forward to spell the word correctly;
- e. Participants will have a maximum of <u>90 seconds</u> only to spell each word correctly. <u>Failure to answer within the time will lead to</u> disqualification:
- f. Participants can ask for the repetition of the word, along with its part of speech and usage in the sentence only <u>THRICE</u>.

## Round 3: Lightning Spelling Round

- a. In this high-paced round, each team will be presented with a set of words to be spelled as swiftly as possible.
- b. Teams must adhere to a time limit of  $\underline{120\ seconds}$  to spell the entire set of words.
- c. The team that successfully spells the highest number of words within this prescribed time frame will be declared the winner.

- d. The competitive twist: As the round progresses, words increase in complexity, adding an element of challenge and excitement to the competition.
- 6. The list of words for preparation is available on:
  - a. www.zsc.edu.pk
  - b. www.sindheducation.gov.pk
- 7. The decision of the jury will be final and questioned by the participants in any manner whatsoever.
- 8. Participants should reach at the venue at-least 15 minutes before the reporting time.
- 9. It is mandatory to have three members in a team. In-case any <u>ONE</u> registered participant due to some unforeseen circumstance is unable to participate the institution can send in the replacement, which should be notified to the jury. It will be the responsibility of the institutional representative to ensure that the jury is timely notified. This is valid for only one-participant replacement.
- 10. When a word is presented by the jury, the participant is required to follow this sequence:
  - a. Pronounce the word aloud, for example, "STARS."
  - b. Spell the word, enunciating each letter, such as "S T A R S."
  - c. Reiterate the word, speaking it once more, in this case, "STARS."
- 11. Participants will be notified about their results on the same day.
- 12. All the participants will be eliqible for a certificate of participation.
- 13. Only the teams qualifying for the finale round shall be invited on the final day of event (Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2023).
